
Dr. Daryll Hull Memorial Fellowship in Industrial Relations Application

Nature of the Award

The fellowship/scholarship will be awarded every two years to a candidate student enrolled or proposed to be enrolled at an Australian university undertaking a research degree (Research Masters or PhD) in the field of industrial relations, including occupational health and safety, labour history and other subfields of industrial relations as determined by the selection committee.

- In the case of awarding the fellowship to a commencing student, payment is conditional upon successful enrolment

The award will be of \$15,000 (in two annual instalments) to the applicant judged the most noteworthy as per the selection criteria.

- The second instalment shall be subject to satisfactory progress as determined by the student's University

Please complete all sections of the application.

Note the completed application *must not exceed three pages* (not including the two academic references) and should contain the following information, numbered as shown below.

1. Full Name of Applicant
2. Degrees held, including honours and grade point averages
3. Other relevant qualifications and work experience
4. Degree program currently enrolled in, or enrolling in
5. Name of University
6. Name of Supervisor, or proposed Supervisor (if known)
7. Title of thesis
8. Aims and methods of the thesis
9. How the thesis contributes to the advancement of knowledge in industrial relations.

The applicant should enclose two letters of support from academic referees.
